Directions from Schellsburg (Route 30) to 1681 Dunkard Hollow Road

- 1. Route 30 to Schellsburg
- 2. At traffic light, take Route 96 North toward New Paris.
- 3. Travel approximately 7.4 miles to Ridge Market and gas station on left.
- 4. Turn LEFT onto Dunkard Hollow Road.
- Travel 3.2 miles (road is windy).
 Slow down....when you see mailbox on right (1681), you will make a sharp LEFT onto driveway at 1681 Dunkard Hollow Road. Gate posts will be marked with orange ribbon.
- 6. Follow driveway, staying to the right as you start up the hill.

Directions from Pleasantville (Route 56) to 1681 Dunkard Hollow Road

- 1. At traffic light, follow Route 56 West for 3.8 miles.
- 2. Watch for sign for RYOT, and at the next intersection, turn **LEFT** onto Dunkard Hollow Road (unmarked).
- 3. Travel 2.2 miles and take the next **RIGHT** onto driveway at 1681 Dunkard Hollow Road. Gate posts will be marked with orange ribbon.
- 4. Follow driveway, staying to the right as you start up the hill.
