1915 - 1987

Ruby Irene Ewald, age 72 of Elkton, passed away Wednesday, Dec. 9 at home following a long illness.

She was born April 15, 1915 in Pigeon, daughter of Edward and Mary (Salzer) Sturm. On April 15, 1936 she was united in marriage to Harry Ewald, who preceded her in death on June 15, 1980.



Mrs. Ewald moved to Elkton after her marriage and worked at The Elkton Advance as a reporter, then became a telephone operator for General Telephone. In 1963 she began work as a secretary at Laker High School, until her retirement in 1979. She was a sales agent for Nimtz Realty and currently for Bay Shore Realty, Caseville.

Mrs. Ewald was a member of the Elkton United Methodist Church, a charter member of the Elkton Woman's Civic Club and the Elkton Extension. She organized and started Club 59. She was a member of the Michigan and Huron County chapters of the Retired School Personnel and the Caseville Eagles #3690 Auxiliary.

She is survived by two brothers, Willard Sturm of Elkton and Vincent Sturm of Pigeon; one sister, Mrs. John (Genevieve) Moore of Elkton and several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were conducted Friday, Dec. 11 at 1 p.m. at the Elkton United Methodist Church. The Rev. James Kummer officiated, with burial in Riverside Cemetery, Elkton.
