



Trabuco RC Flyers ***Flight Line Protocols***



1. Before turning on your radio, you **MUST** have the frequency pin if flying on 72MHz. 2.4GHz does not require a pin.
2. If you are sharing a radio channel, you **MUST** impound your radio by putting it on the hooks in the frequency control stand area. (IF YOU SHOOT DOWN A PLANE DUE TO FAILURE TO IMPOUND, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO REPLACE IT).
3. Pilot's must be in one of the five flight stands while flying.
4. When going on or across the runway for any reason announce **"ON THE RUNWAY"** loudly enough so other flyers can hear you.
5. When taxiing on to the runway, announce loudly enough **"COMING OUT"**.
6. When landing, announce loudly enough **"LANDING"** on your downwind leg.
7. When you are dead stick, announce loudly enough **"DEAD STICK"**. Dead stick landings have priority over all others.
8. Non pilot or cadet children must stay behind the pit area for their safety unless accompanied by an adult.
9. Clean your area, put away your table and chairs when you are done flying.
10. There is food and drinks in the refrigerators in the snack shack. The prices are on the wall. We operate under the honor system.
11. The barbeques are for members & guests to use. We ask when you are finished cooking, to turn off the BBQ **AND** close the valve on the propane tank.
12. When backing into a space with your vehicle, try to keep close to the next vehicle to allow space for everyone. Do not park or drive on any black top area.
13. Please follow the posted flight pattern and avoid the restricted flight zone.
14. You must have a Fire extinguisher with you at all times when flying. If you forget, you can either rent one for the day at a cost of \$5.00 or you can purchase one from the club at club cost.
