

A MESSAGE FROM THE WEBER COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

Citizens of Weber County:

It is that time of year again when the weather warms up and more people are out on the streets at night. We want to remind people that vehicle and garage burglaries increased because of this. Please remember to ALWAYS lock your vehicles, remove anything valuable from your vehicle and double check that your garages are shut. Criminals prey on crimes of opportunity and locking vehicles, garage man doors and shutting your garages dramatically decrease the amount of burglaries that happen. Deputies are constantly driving neighborhoods looking for these individuals and quite often come across open garages. You may get a knock on the door late at night to shut your garage, which may be somewhat inconvenient, but we would rather prevent a burglary from happening rather than taking a report the next day.

If you see someone trying to get into vehicles or garages, please call 911 immediately and Deputies will respond quickly. If you see any suspicious vehicles or people in an area, please call the non-emergency Dispatch line at 801-629-8221 and we will gladly respond to find out what they are up to.
