Join the Eucharistic Pilgrimage Across America when it comes to our very own Diocese of Harrisburg at 4 different stops from June 3rd – June 5th.


What is the National Eucharistic Revival?

Just in case you have not heard about this yet, the entire Catholic Church in the United States of America is participating in a National Eucharistic Revival from Summer 2022 – Summer 2025. Here in Shippensburg, we increased the time spent in Eucharistic Adoration, and I've been mainly writing bulletin articles here in Shippensburg each week to help us understand the Catholic Mass. Overall, here is the basic timeline of the entire 3-year process, and we are now in the midst of the Eucharistic Pilgrimage across the United States, which will end in late July with a Eucharistic Congress (a national conference) to pray, reflect, learn, and worship Jesus in the Eucharist! Here is the basic timeline to give you the overall picture:

June 19, 2022 --- Eucharistic Revival Begins:

- Year #1 = Diocesan Renewal (ended on June 11, 2023)
- Year #2 = Parish Renewal (wraps up w/two big events on May 17, 2024)
 - Ends w/(1) a two-month pilgrimage/journey across the U.S.A. (May 17 – July 16, 2024)
 - And w/(2) the pilgrimage ending in Indianapolis, IN for a weekend Conference called the National Eucharistic Congress (July 17th-21st, 2024)
- Year #3 = National Renewal and sending us out as missionaries (July 21, 2024 – Summer 2025)

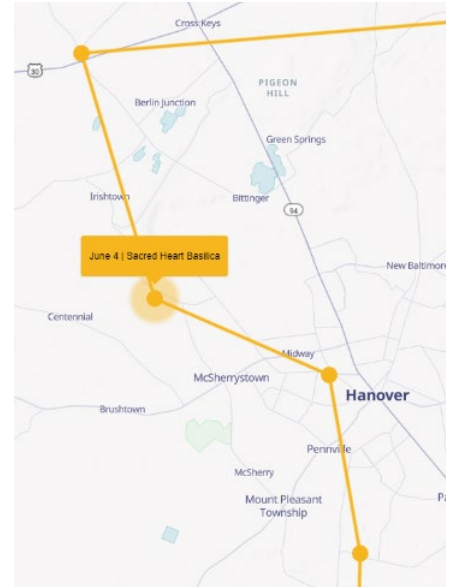
Right now, the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage is happening across the United States, and designated pilgrims are walking four different pathways to get to Indianapolis for the Congress in July. You can see that the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Route comes directly through our area, and it stops at 4 churches in our very own Diocese of Harrisburg! **[[turn paper over for details on the special events you can attend!]]**

Five Special Events (You can join for all five events below, OR for just one of these events, OR for just part of each separate event!)

- **Bonus Event – Monday, June 3rd – New Oxford, PA – @ Immaculate Conception**
 - **All day & All night!** Eucharistic Adoration in the Main Church

- 1. **Tuesday, June 4th – New Oxford, PA --- @ Immaculate Conception**
 - a. **8 am**, Celebration of the Mass
 - b. **8:45 am**, Breakfast following Mass
 - c. **9:45 – 10:15 am**, Begin Procession to Sacred Heart – **4+ mile walk between churches!!**
- 2. **Tuesday, June 4th – Hanover, PA --- @ Sacred Heart Basilica**
 - a. **Begins at Noon and includes, Lunch, mid-day prayer, and adoration**
 - b. **From 12:00 pm until around 1:30 pm**
 - c. **1:30 pm**, Begin Procession to St. Vincent de Paul – **~ 3 mile walk between churches!**
- 3. **Tuesday, June 4th – Hanover, PA --- @ St. Vincent de Paul**
 - a. **Water break and some prayer**
 - b. **2:30 pm**, Begin Procession to St. Joseph – **~ 3 miles walk between churches!**
- 4. **Tuesday, June 4th – Hanover, PA --- @ St. Joseph**
 - a. **5:00 pm**, Adoration and Evening Prayer in the Church
 - b. **Followed by, A Big Dinner** that is open to all (if you sign up!)
 - c. **Event ends throughout the evening**
- 5. **Wednesday, June 5th – Hanover, PA – @ St. Joseph**
 - a. **8:45 am**, Adoration and then Mass in the main church
 - b. **~ 10:00 am**, Breakfast after Mass and then sending off the pilgrims to their next stop!!

***Please Note: The Diocese of Harrisburg will have one shuttle running between these FOUR churches from 1:00 pm until 8:00 pm, in case you park at one church and walk to the other locations to help you get back to your vehicle.
