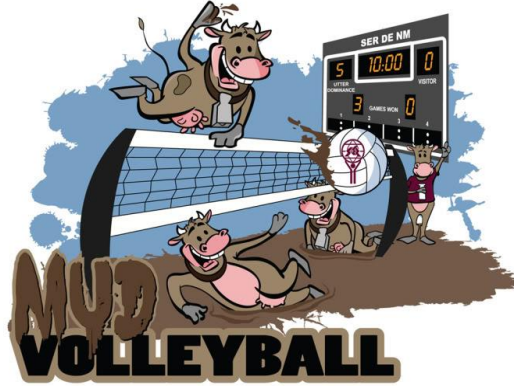


# Franklin County Fair 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Co-Ed Mud Volleyball Tournament

1st Place: \$150

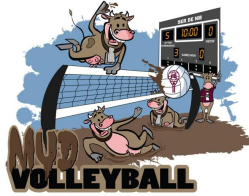
- Teams may be limited. No spots will be held

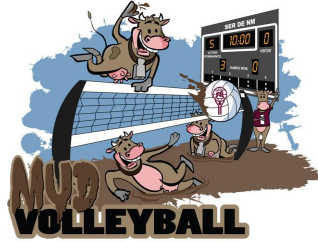

## **PARTICIPANT RULES:**

Under 18 years need parental waiver.

Participants may only play on one team.

Please remember that clothing will become wet and this is a family event. It is recommended that swimsuits be worn under clothing.

Taping of shorts to tuck in shirts to prevent shorts from falling off is recommended for elastic waist bands without ties.

There are NO officials, only a Court Supervisor. Teams must compete on the honor system.

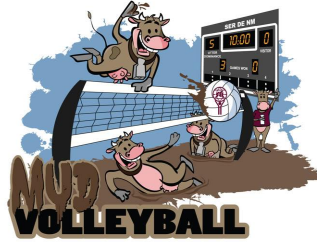
Spectators and substitute players must remain 5 feet from the play area. No children allowed in the play area even when play has been suspended.

Matches will continue in the rain. In the event that lightning is sighted, the Court Supervisor reserves the right to suspend play, alter, and/or cancel matches at his/her discretion.

No alcohol may be brought onto the premises. No outside food or drink allowed.

## GAME RULES

Co-Ed Teams: Minimum of 6, maximum of 10 on roster - must have 3 men/3women on court at all time	To serve, you must have one heel on the “back wall”. Over hand serves allowed.
6 vs. 6 on the court - 3 men/3 women \$10 per player to enter.	Players must make every effort to clean the ball before initiating play. Any team purposely adding mud to the ball will be penalized a point.
Each team captain must check in with the Court Supervisor 30 minutes before they are scheduled to play. We will play on a rolling schedule so if a match finishes early and both teams are checked in we will start early.	All matches will be rally scoring, best 2 out of 3. First two games are to 25 points with a cap of 27. The third game is to 15 points with a cap of 17.
It is the Captain’s responsibility to get the results of the match to the court supervisor immediately following the match.	Games may NOT be protested.
The mud pit is about the size of a regulation volleyball court and up to 15 inches deep with mud and/or water.	Some examples of violations in play: attack or block the serve, attack the ball with two hands.
Line calls are based on an honor system. If the ball touches water/mud it’s in, if it hits land it is considered out.	Lift rule is “Prolonged Contact” this is a judgment call. If the team disagrees, then the play will be replayed.
A player must stay “in bounds” to play the ball. If they step out the play will be considered illegal.	Net Violations are in effect. No one is allowed to touch the net at any time.
Intentional delay of the game will result in a penalty point.	If all else fails REPLAY the point.
Each team is allowed one 60 second time out.
