MAUREPAS STUDENT FLIES HIGH! (AGAIN)



Kameron A. is anything but your average Maurepas High student. He is the only pole-vaulter on the MHS Track Team, a position he accredits to his former track sponsor Coach Garland. In a quite ironic twist, Kameron lacked an interest in track initially, settling for the sport when he missed the deadline to join the MHS Cross Country Team. The rest is history. Kameron began pole-vaulting his sixth grade year, gradually improving his height, and in his eighth grade year, he had secured his first parish and LHSAA Class C State Championship at twelve feet and eleven feet, respectively. The following year he achieved his second LHSAA Class C State Championship at thirteen feet, six inches. Last year, he garnered another state championship yet this time in class B at fifteen feet. This year, Kameron attended the National Pole-vault Summit in Reno, Nevada, and placed first with a height of fifteen feet, ten inches (**the current school record and his personal record**). Most recently, Kameron attended the LHSAA Division II Indoor State Championship. He attained second place at a height of fifteen feet, eight and a half inches. Kameron stands as the second best vaulter in Louisiana and the fifth highest junior vaulter in the nation this season. As a former track team member and colleague of Kameron, it has been awesome to see him grow and accomplish new records as an athlete. I am sure both teachers and students alike are Maurepas Proud of Kameron. We all would like to wish him the best of luck as he attends the New Balance Indoor Nationals in New York City on March 10. Keep shooting for the stars (literally)!

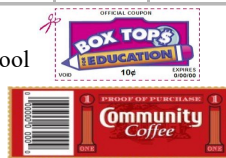
