As with any owner-surrendered animal we must have the available space to take in each pet. We also require a surrender fee, PER PET. Behavioral and health assessments are performed by our Executive Director for each animal prior to surrender.

For this reason, many people opt to have the mother and her offspring spayed/neutered and re-home the animals themselves. By spaying and neutering your pets, you are doing your part to prevent future unwanted litters, and making it easier to re-home the puppies or kittens to new families.
