D. Ervin Hamilton, age 95 of Pigeon, passed away Friday, February 6, at Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon.

He was born in Berne, Kansas, son of the late David N. and Fannie (Smith) Hamilton. On March 20, 1913, he was united in marriage to Elizabeth Mary Teuscher in Tuleta, Texas. She preceded him in death on March 22, 1960.
