What is this project?

The Millerton Pedestrian Plan seeks to create a more walkable, pedestrian-friendly Village. The Plan consists of three parts: 1) an inventory of sidewalks and other walking-related infrastructure; 2) prioritized recommendations to improve pedestrian access and safety; and 3) design concepts for Main Street and Century Boulevard. The Plan is being led by the Dutchess County Transportation Council (DCTC) in coordination with a local Task Force. The presentation will share results of the inventory and our draft recommendations and design concepts.
