<p>Actual Cost to Educate a Student</p> <p>The actual cost is found by dividing our total budget by the number of students enrolled in our school. St. Mary's has done a great job of keeping our costs low and cutting all extra spending to enable our school to operate within a sustainable budget. The difference between the actual cost to educate a student and the tuition you pay is met through parish subsidies, fund raising, gifts, and contributions. Families who are able to do so are invited to contribute any amount toward this difference to help meet costs each year.</p>	<p>\$5,133</p>
<p>Parish Subsidy Per Student</p> <p>St. Mary Parish contributes significantly to your child's education. St. Augustine Parish in our cluster also contributes toward this cost. Your child benefits from these contributions. Your active participation and financial support of these parishes helps to keep your tuition costs down. Families who are able to do so are invited to prayerfully consider paying part or all of the parish subsidy amount.</p>	<p>\$1,798</p>
<p>Fund raising and Scrip per Student</p> <p>Because the parish subsidy and tuition do not fully meet the financial obligations to educate a child, we rely on fund raising to bring in additional money. Each family is asked to purchase a minimum amount of Scrip and volunteer service in the school, as well as supporting school fund raisers.</p>	<p>\$1,199</p>
<p>Minimum Tuition per Student</p> <p>This is the tuition for kindergarten through grade 5. This is the minimum amount we can charge and still be able to educate your child to their fullest potential.</p>	<p>\$2,136</p>
