- **Jingle Bell Jazz** December 21st at the Farmer's Market. Estimate \$1600 in ticket sales, \$950 to rent the Farmers Market, \$100 for chairs, approximate \$800 for food, and \$200 for promotion. Working on getting sponsors to help cover costs. Possibly a tin can raffle. We will need to bring our coat rack. Will only have 200 chairs, but Christie Siegel will have high top tables available for the night. Ticket prices are \$10 for adults, \$5 for seniors and students. Christie Siegel is handling the printing of the flyers and posters, and extra publicity. The event will be alcohol free. There are sponsor ads available in the program. A bio for each professional performer will be in the program. Need to get more signs.
- Chicago trip- Sign up! 1 more Remind will go out.
- **Concert day signage** Feather signs vs. Sandwich board. Feather sign is much more impactful. Cost about \$200, but cheaper on-line
- Marching Band Festival DVD's- \$5 per order goes to us. We had 45 orders.
