- Section 1. In accordance with NYS Executive Law, Section 381 (2), The Town of Cohocton, New York hereby reclaims the rights, responsibilities, powers and duties to enforce the NYS Uniform Fire Prevention & Building Code commencing the effective date of this Local Law.
- Section 2. Further, in accordance with NYS Executive Law, Section 381 (2), the Town of Cohocton, New York acknowledges herewith that it may relinquish the same rights, responsibilities, powers, and duties at a later date by repealing this Local Law before July 1st of the prior year.
- Section 3. Local Law No. 3 of the Town of Cohocton, New York, enacted on June 14, 1983, is hereby repealed.

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. of 19 of the County of Schoharie was duly passed by the Town Board (Name of Legislative Body) on 1984 and was approved by the Elective Chief Executive Officer \* on 1984. Such local law being subject to a permissive referendum and no valid petition requesting such referendum having been filed, said local law was deemed duly adopted on 1984, in accordance with the applicable provisions of law.

\*Elective Chief Executive Officer means or includes the chief executive officer of a county elected on a county-wide basis or, if there be none, the chairman of the county legislative body, the mayor of a city or village or the supervisor of a town, where such officer is vested with power to approve or veto local laws or ordinances.
