## Mandatory Language for Monitoring and Reporting Violation Failure to Submit a Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report (DLQOR)

## MONITORING, ROUTINE (DBP), MAJOR/CHLORINE

The Lawrence WSC water system PWS ID 1290018 has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

These violations occurred in the monitoring periods 2Q2023 and 3Q2023.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue: While Lawrence WSC did meet the monitoring requirements for 2Q2023 and 3Q2023, the reports were received after the deadline. Monitoring and reporting activities are up to date.
