RESPECT LIFE SUNDAY !

The month of October has a lot of events happening and one of those is Respect Life Sunday. Of course, we are supposed to respect life every day, but it is a reminder to us how precious human life is and that it needs to be protected. Abortion is certainly what most people think about when we think about respecting life, but it involves several other topics as well.

For instance, Free Speech Week at Berkeley University was cancelled recently because there were death threats against at least one of the conservative speakers that were scheduled. You don't have to kill someone just because you disagree with that person! It might have just been somebody trying to get the week cancelled, but it shows that the desire for violence in our country has escalated.

A group or organization that supports violence as a means to achieve what they want is not a group that truly respects life. We should only be fighting someone if we are defending ourselves from harm. Respecting life includes the lives of those you disagree with and don't like. You should not beat up or kill an abortionist, but pray for their conversion.

Another way to respect life is to visit the elderly. It is sad when I talk to someone in a nursing home and find out that nobody visits him or her. When you take the time to visit someone, you show that they have value and that you care about them. You can bring a smile to a face that has been frowning all day.

Married couples who are having trouble conceiving a child can show respect for life by not considering in vitro fertilization. When the sperm and egg from the couple are combined in a lab to make embryos. Often many embryos are produced and the doctor will recommend "selective reduction" of the embryos, which is just another way to say abortion. Adopting a child is the right choice because it respects life and respects the body.

Iceland was happy to report that it had reduced those kids born with Down's Syndrome by a huge amount. The problem was that it was not reduced by therapy or finding a cure, but by most women aborting their child once they found out their child had Down's Syndrome. Iceland was not showing a respect for life. We are all beautiful children of God regardless of our condition or capabilities. Also, in my life I have found those with Down's Syndrome to be some of the most kind and joyful people I have ever met.

Respecting life is like our faith- Not something to turn on and off, but to always keep on and be nurtured. We will have to answer to God about what we did on this earth and what we failed to do. Can you imagine God asking you the following? - "Did you respect the life I created? Did you see me in others? Did you take advantage of the life I gave you?"

Respecting life is a yes to God's will!
