President's Message

First thing I want to do is thank all of our members who participated in the July tournament! It was one of the largest turnouts for a tournament in the last 8 years! Also, thanks to all the board members that have come together and created a safe way to check-in and process everyone as quickly as we can. This is no easy task, under very difficult and restrictive circumstances.

I know this might sound like a broken record, but it cannot be stated enough. Although we exist as a social club, we do have a responsibility to maintain a competitive environment that follows the rules. Many times, those rules may seem harsh or even in contrast to the social aspect of our club. I assure you, those rules are what allow our club to function so well, because it treats all of us exactly the same.

There is ALWAYS a rules sheet laid out at the check-in table for tournaments. There will always be a board member that will take the time to answer any questions you may have concerning the rules for competition. If you are not sure you filled out a scorecard correctly, please ask after the competition for help. There is no penalty for asking someone to ensure it's filled out correctly, before turning it in. Even though someone else did the scoring, it is the player's responsibility to ensure it was done correctly.

Below are a few basic rules and guidelines that we continue to struggle with during skins games and tournaments.

- If you write your name and distance on a CP, you MUST right it legibly, and you shall write it in Ft and inches (1' 2" NOT 14"). Less than a foot, you shall write in inches only.
- Scorecards must be filled in completely, even if you select your partner's score, both scores must be filled in for accountability.
- · Scorecards must be signed!!
- When turning in a scorecard for a skins game or tournament, birdies MUST be circled, or they will not count
- When turning in a scorecard for skins game, you MUST right first and last names, or the card may be discarded, and all scores and birdies disregarded for the competition.
- Sharing information about club selection and reading greens, with others in your group! This must stop!

All players should be VERY careful in giving advice to your playing partners, without ensuring that advice is accurate. IF that advice is followed and it's inaccurate, it can result in disqualification or loss of a skin.

Below are a few recent examples where players gave other players wrong information:

- Tree branches that are down due to wind but have not begun to be removed by the maintenance, are NOT ground under repair. You MUST play the ball as it lies or play it as unplayable lie.
- Bunkers for now, are considered lift clean and place only, with placement being no closer to the hole. You may not remove your ball from a bunker with free relief. This is the ONLY local rule we have changed due to Covid19, everything else is the SAME.
- In a tournament, you must hole out your ball for the score to count. Hitting the stick does not count as being holed.
