And we didn't think he could out do himself? THANKS AGAIN JAY!!!

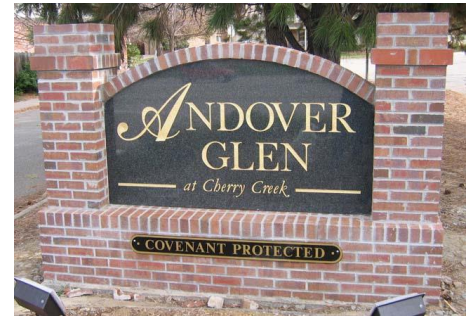
