### HUD-VASH HOUSING

A permanent housing program using HUD Section 8 vouchers designated for Veterans. Assists homeless Veterans in transitioning to independent living in the community.

### GRANT & PER DIEM HOUSING

Located in Johnson City, Knoxville and Kingsport. Offers long-term housing, case management, and access to the full range of VA medical care while assisting Veterans in transitioning to permanent housing and independent living in the community.

### HOMELESS VETERANS OUTREACH

Initial contact for Veterans for VA enrollment and links to all VA services and programs.

### VETERANS JUSTICE OUTREACH (VJO)

Provides eligible justice involved Veterans with timely access to VA services and benefits.

### DCHV CONTRACT HOUSING

Provides rapid transition from street homelessness and helps Veterans at risk for homelessness obtain temporary housing.
