





This card must be filled out and mailed by the purchaser to Ben Pearson, Pine Bluff, Arkansas, WITHIN TEN (10) DAYS AFTER PURCHASE. If failure occurs in this registered bow due to faulty material or workmanship, Ben Pearson will repair or replace as per schedule listed below, providing the bow does not show any evidence of misuse or improper handling.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL ADJUSTMENTS BE MADE WHEN THE BOW LIMBS ARE TWISTED OR DAMAGED DUE TO IMPROPER STRINGING.

Otherwise, should failure occur, first write to Ben Pearson. Please explain nature of the failure and include bow name, serial number, weight and date of bow's purchase. Upon receipt of this information, we will forward shipping instructions and a special return form authorizing your shipment. We will not be responsible for unauthorized shipments.

If original owner has registered the bow within 10 days after purchase and finds its performance is unsatisfactory within 30 days of purchase, he may return it to the Sovereign dealer for full refund of investment to date.




