      - 1. Shakopee
        - 2. 60 Units
        - 3. Not currently zoned for multi-family
          - a. Working with city to try to rezone
        - 4. Going in front of board in April for proposed rezoning
        - 5. Near Jackson Elementary and HS
        - 6. Child Center near by
        - 7. \$54K is about 60% AMI for family of 4
        - 8. BOB COUGHLEN
          - a. Are you looking for a site rezoning or looking for redevelop whole area.
          - b. D.R. Horton has zoning for rest of area already done.
            - i. Request rezone and 4 acres of High Density
            - ii. City said no
            - iii. Has rest of zoning in place and CommonBond will be going in for explicitly 60 units for site with complete plan as is.
            - iv. Presenting this as 1 piece of larger town home, single home, senior housing development
            - v. D.R. Horton will join in community meeting

  - ii. Canterbury just got huge subsidy without any affordable housing

  - ii. If they start going down density route.
    - 1. Point out Canterbury density with TIFF and much higher
  - iii. SMSC is a large employer and has a hard time filling positions having workforce housing units helps
  - iv. Suggests talking with MVTA and Transit to discuss resources to project
