COVID Update

Good Afternoon from Midway Nursing Home!

This is an update to yesterday's COVID notification.

There are no new positive cases for either residents or staff. Per NYS & NYC DOH guidance and out of an abundance of caution, the entire facility remains on quarantine until 14 days have passed. The 2 residents who tested positive remain asymptomatic and no other residents are displaying signs or symptoms of COVID as of today.

All residents continue to be closely monitored and on droplet and contact isolation precautions through the end of the quarantine period. Staff continue to utilize full PPE for every resident encounter. Resident movement remains limited to their rooms and enhanced cleaning measures continue as well.

Unfortunately, all visitation, including window visits remains on pause. If you would like to schedule a virtual visit, please contact the Social Work or Recreation Departments.

We want to assure you that we are doing everything possible to keep your loved ones safe.
