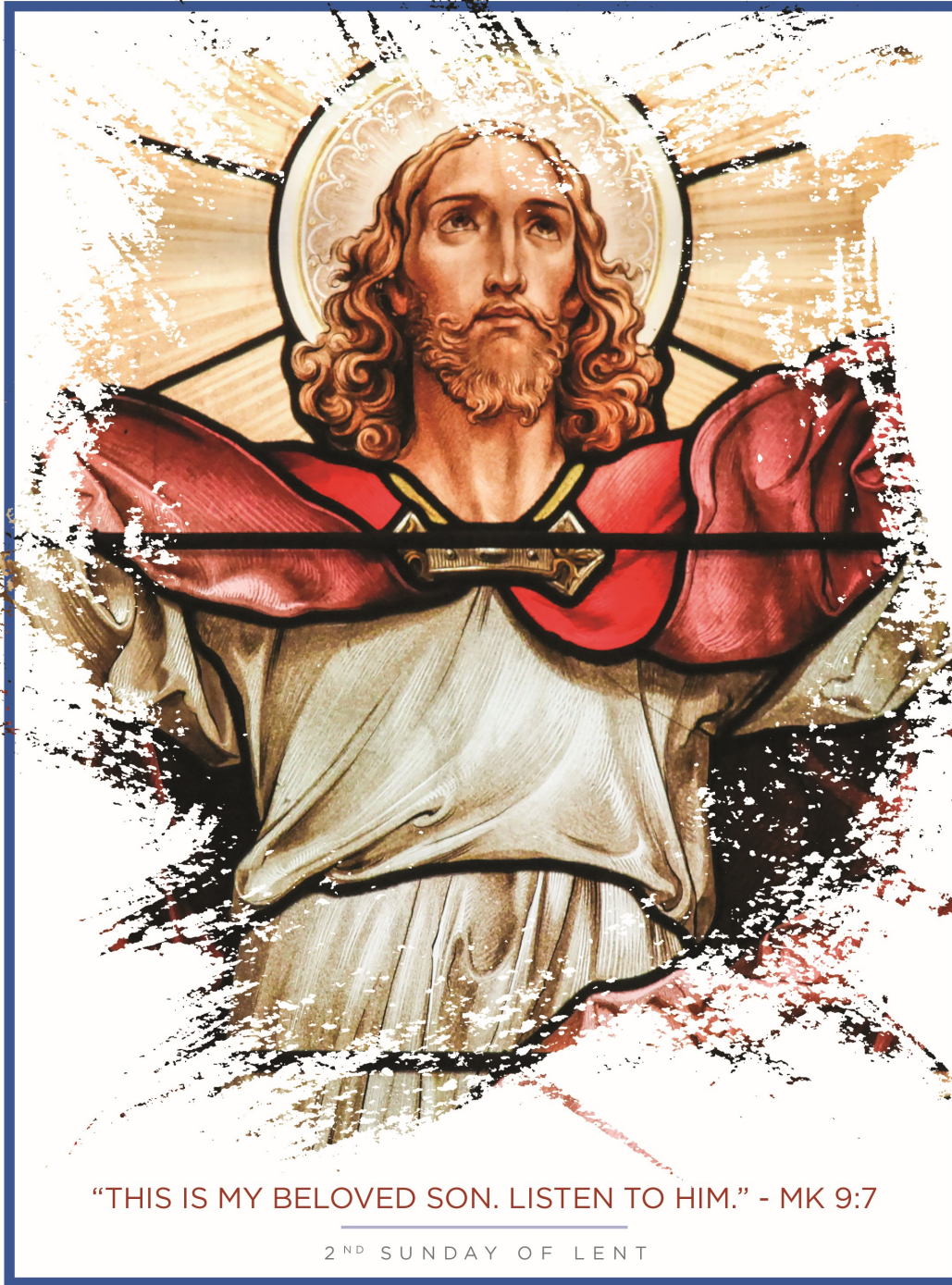

QUICK FACTS ABOUT ST. JOSEPH

1. Joseph is the patron saint of many things, including the universal Church, fathers, the dying, social justice, unborn children, travelers, immigrants, a happy death, families, pregnant women, house sellers & buyers, craftsmen, engineers, & working people in general.
2. According to tradition, Joseph died in the arms of Jesus & Mary, which is why he is considered the model of the pious believer who receives grace at the moment of death, in other words, the patron of a happy death.
3. The month of March is dedicated to St. Joseph & his primary feast day (Solemnity of St. Joseph, husband of Mary) is March 19th.

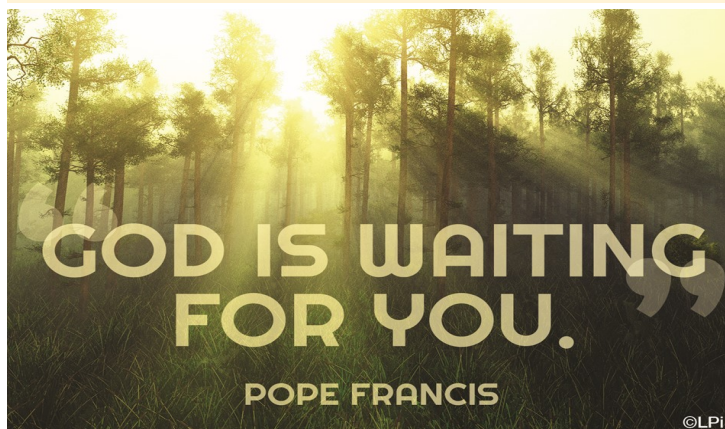

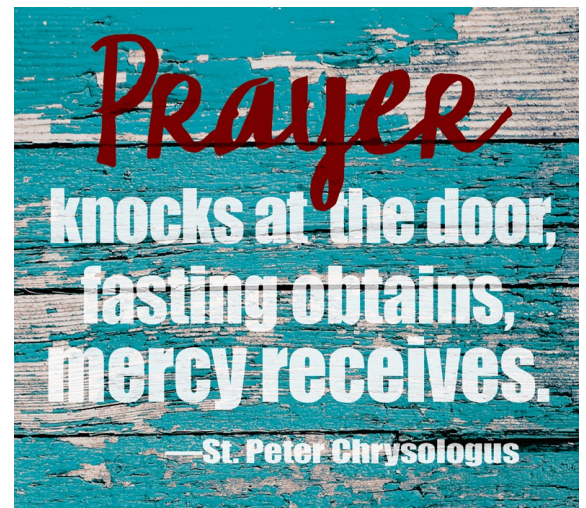
