2. Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting

A motion to accept minutes as read was made by Samuel Scapellato and seconded by Andrew Bellone Jr. No changes to be made.

3. Treasurers Report & Bills against the Commission

Joseph Scapellato reported: The 2023 Workmans Compensation insurance policy renewal was paid.

The 4th quarter tax payment was received and deposited.

Petty cash balance in the amount of 0.00 – end of year balance of 0.28 was re-deposited into the bank.

A motion to pay all bills and to accept the Treasurers report was made by Mykola Myronowskyj and seconded by Samuel Scapellato.



4. Old Business

Mykola Myronowskyj reported commented on the following:

Filing of documents that he can locate from 2011 and prior. The files that are being archived are being organized, then scanned and then filed.

Mykola Myronowskyj continues to work on the Forest Grove equipment audit.

The MUA's for the surrounding locals that have not been completed yet will begin as soon as possible.

The 2021 financial audit is in progress. Mykola Myronowskyj spoke to Ed Paul and he advised that the audit should be completed soon, Mr. Paul is still waiting for information from the state. Mr. Paul further advised that none of the audits for any of the fire districts have been completed.

At the November meeting Andrew Bellone Jr. suggested another type of reward structure be created for active fire fighters that respond to fires. He suggested a few different types of rewards such as clothing allowance, fuel cost reimbursement, etc. Andrew Bellone Jr. wants to investigate an additional rewards system. Mykola Myronowskyj reminded him that we already have LOSAP as the rewards system and he is not sure if a second type of reward is legal, but we will need to review.

5. New Business

Mykola Myronowskyj reported:

The 2023 Workmans Compensation insurance package was received. The insurance package was reviewed by all Commissioner's present.

The 2023 GenServe generator maintenance contract was received. The total for the contract will be \$900.00. The contract was reviewed by all Commissioner's present and Chairman Andrew Bellone signed the renewal.

The Board received a letter from Douglas Adams of the Buena Borough Council. Buena Borough Council received a petition to dissolve Buena Borough Fire District #2 (Minotola). Please refer to their letter and our response below.

Resolution 2022-05 to set a temporary budget for 2023 until the annual election in February was read and adopted. The vote to approve this resolution was unanimous Please refer below.

Resolution 2022-06 to reallocate reserve fund balance to overspent budget line items was read and adopted. The vote to approve this resolution was unanimous Please refer below.

Resolution # 2022-05 BoFC Temporary Budget Resolution for CY 2023

WHEREAS, it has become necessary for the Commissioners of Fire District No. 4 in the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, by resolution, to adopt a temporary budget to make appropriations and to provide for the period between the beginning of the fiscal year January 1, 2023, and the adoption of the budget by the legal voters of the fire district, which election is scheduled for February 18, 2023.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commissioners of Fire District No. 4 in the Township of Franklin, County of Gloucester, as follows:

A temporary budget in the amount of \$75,831.00 is hereby adopted pursuant to N.J.S.A 40A:14-78.17 to be effective from the beginning of the fiscal year as noted above and to be in full force and effect until the adoption of the annual fire district budget as referenced above; the total of the appropriations of the temporary budget to reflect not in excess of 14% of the total of the appropriations made for all purposes in the budget for the preceding fiscal year exclusive of appropriations for interest and debt redemption charges and capital improvements.

2023 ADOPTED BUDGET RESOLUTION

Franklin Township FD No. 4 (Gloucester)

FISCAL YEAR: January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget for the Franklin Township FD No. 4 (Gloucester) (the 'Fire District') for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2023 and ending December 31, 2023 has been presented for adoption before the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District at its open public meeting of December 27,2022; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as presented for adoption reflects each item of revenue and apprpriation in the same amount and title as set forth in the introduced and approved budget, including all amendments thereto, if any, which have been approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services; and

WHEREAS, the adopted budget is in compliance with the Property Tax Levy Cap Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.44 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as presented for adoption reflects Total Revenues of \$675,312.95 which includes amount to be raised by taxation of \$552,482.00, and Total Appropriations of \$675,312.95; and

WHEREAS, an election shall be held annually on the third Saturday of February in each established fire district to determine the amount to be raised by taxation for the ensuing year;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District at an open public meeting held on December 27,2022 that the Annual Budget of the Fire District for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2023 and ending December 31, 2023 is hereby adopted and, shall constitute appropriations for the purposes stated and authorization of Total Revenues of \$675,312.95, which includes amount to be raised by taxation of \$552,482.00, and Total Appropriations of \$675,312.95; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Annual Budget as presented for adoption reflects each item of revenue and appropriation in the same amount and title as set forth in the introduced and approved budget, including all amendments thereto, if any, which have been approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that an annual election shall be held on the third Saturday of February to determine the amount to be raised by taxation for the ensuing year. The results of which shall be subsequently certified to the Division and the Municipal Assessor.

Dear Commissioner Chairman of Forest Grove Fire District,

In November 2022, Buena Borough Council received and filed a petition signed by not less than 5%

of the voters to dissolve Buena Borough Fire District No. 2 (Minotola) in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:14-

91, thereby having the Borough Council undertake the oversight of fire suppression and prevention instead

of a fire commission. In accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:14-68; Buena Boro may contract with a volunteer

fire company or companies in such municipality, for purposes of extinguishing fires, upon such terms and

conditions as shall be deemed proper.

By law Buena Boro Mayor & Council must act upon this petition, therefore Ordinance #715 was cre-

ated to consider dissolving Fire Dist No. 2. Mayor & Council must act on the Ordinance and vote for or

against dissolving Fire Dist. No. 2. Should Mayor & Council vote in favor, Fire Dist No. 2 would be dis-

solved allowing the governing body to oversee fire suppression and prevention with the Minotola Fire Com-

pany or such other fire company that may be created for the purposes of providing fire suppression ser-

vices to the Borough residents, as authorized in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:14-68.

Many rumors have been spread that Buena Boro Mayor & Council are closing Minotola Fire Com-

pany. First, that is not true, second, our governing body does not have the authority to carry out such ac-

tion. Should the fire district get dissolved, we would like Minotola Fire Co. to continue providing their ser-

vices.

On November 30, at a public Council meeting, a representative of Minotola Fire Co. addressed

Buena Boro Mayor & Council and threatened that should Mayor & Council dissolve the Fire District, over

20 Minotola Firemen would resign from the Fire Co. A packet containing the firemen's resignations was

then distributed.

Mayor and Council must continue with this process until it is voted upon. Should Council vote in fa-

vor of dissolving the fire district, and Minotola Firemen invoke their resignations, Buena Boro will need tem-

porary assistance from its neighbors for fire suppression.



We are asking all of our neighboring fire companies for their temporary help and assistance as first

responders, mutual aid, and if need be a Shared Service agreement.

Presently, over 20 persons are moving forward with obtaining the necessary certifications to operate a fire company. If the District is dissolved all of the assets of the District, including all of the equipment in the possession of Minotola Fire Company will belong to the Borough to be used for a new fire company should Minotola members choose to resign, at which point we will only require mutual aide from our neighbors and would provide the same as well.

We hope Minotola Firemen reconsider their actions, but if they don't we need to have a plan and we

need to be prepared to protect our residents.
