DIVORCE LAW IN HAWAII is a free public education program sponsored by the Family Court providing practical guidance on the law and process of divorce, divorce resolution options, and how to resolve a divorce without conflict or unnecessary expense.

The **KAPOLEI SESSIONS** of Divorce Law in Hawaii will be held on-site at the Family Court located at the First Circuit Family Court Kapolei Courthouse, 4675 Kapolei Parkway, Kapolei, Hawaii.
