You may also hand deliver your entry to the Library's front desk up to September 22. If return of entry is desired, a proper self-addressed envelope must be enclosed. Noted adults will be contacted if children are invited to read their poetry or receive awards.

Recognition - Series of the submitted poems will be selected to be read by their young poets at the BookFest's Poetry Tent to open the festivities on Saturday, October 7tht at 10 am. If desired, a prominent local poet will read it with the young poet. Judges will select top poems in each category to be awarded special prizes and a certificate. Best poems will be published in a book presented to winners (free downloadable copy will also be available). Tent will be on Washington Ave, at Haddon and if rain will be at the High School.
