Here are the seven happy winners in order:

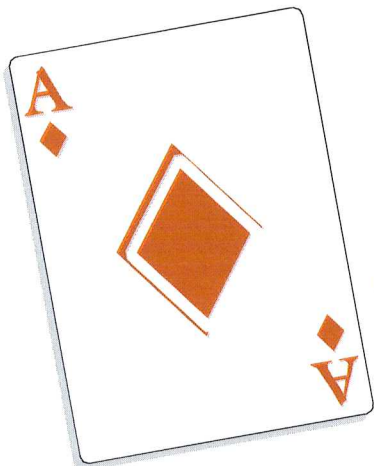

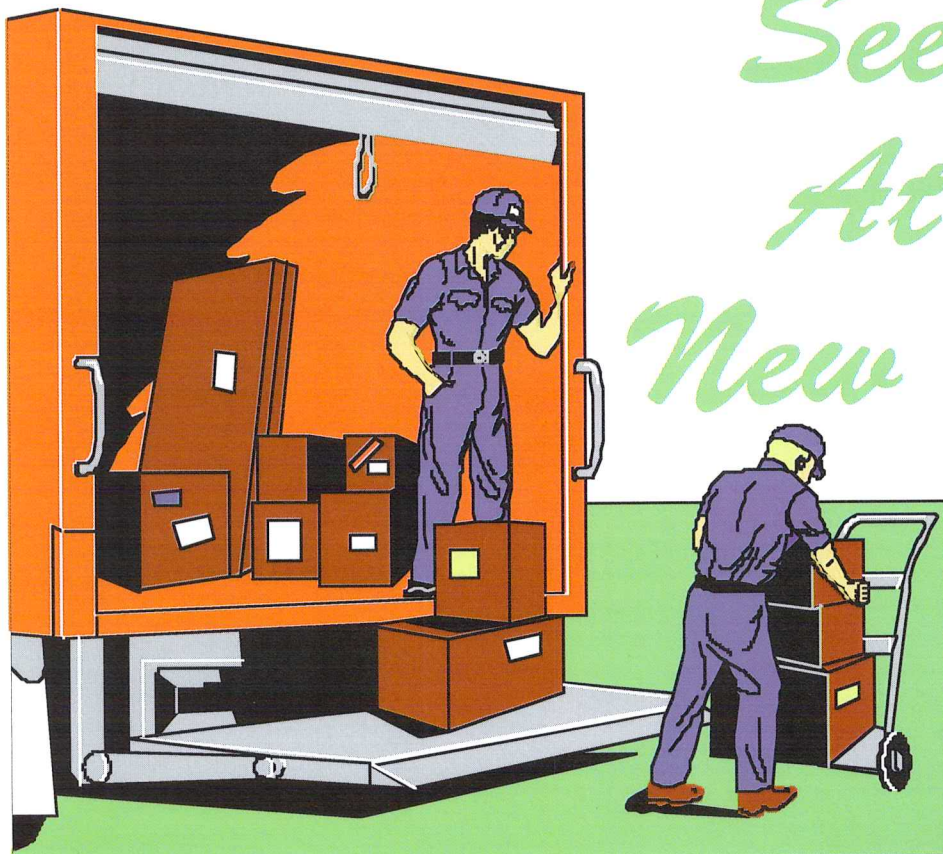
