FIRST WEEK OF SCHOOL - Wow! What an awesome first week of school we've had! Thank you to everyone for helping to make the transition to preschool go so smoothly!!

SHOW-N-TELL - Beginning next week, Monday, September 16th Miss Sara and Miss Kalonie's classes will be doing **Show-N-Tell**. The morning class and full day class have split their kids to bring their special something on either Monday or Thursday. Please see the enclosed sheet for your child's day. Please encourage your child to bring something that is special to them!

DROP OFF/PICK UP - Now that we are two weeks into school, we would like to encourage you to have a "drop-off routine" that you do with your child. An example of this may look like... Walking down the hallway with you, coming into the cubby area where you help them get their backpack put away, inside shoes on, two kisses, one on left cheek, one on right cheek, big hug, walking them into classroom, saying goodbye and then departing. Establishing a routine for drop off will allow your child to receive instruction from their teachers and gain confidence in their ability to function separate from their parents. This is a vital step in them learning how to do for themselves and will help us in our goal to give them the confidence they need to do harder tasks as the year progresses!
