JUNE 15, 2019

Town of Delcambre regular session convened at 6:00 p.m. on JUNE 15, 2019, at the City Hall, with Mayor Pam Blakely, presiding.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Timothy Derise and seconded by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan "moved to accept and dispense the minutes of the regular meeting of May 13, 2019 as reviewed." Motion Carried:

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderman Donald Martin "moved to authorize payment of monthly bills as reviewed." Motion Carried:

DISCUSSION: Street Commissioner Homer Stelly, reports the Water Meter construction is going as schedule with no major complications found. Installation of 135 meters installed as of date.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Donald Martin and seconded by Alderwoman Madison Saunier "moved to table Fire Department roof repair until proof of warranties and debris disposal are provided". Motion Carried.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderwoman Madison Saunier and Alderman Bryan Glatter seconded by "moved to table City Hall/Police Department roof repair until proof of warranties and debris disposal are provided". Motion Carried.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderwoman Madison Saunier "moved to adopt the Amended Ordinance - *Driving or Boating Through Barricades Sec. 5-90, 5-91 and 5-92. To Criminalize the Act of Driving and/or Boating Around Barricades and Driving or Boating Through Standing Water in Such a Manner as to Create a Wake and Jeopardize the Property and/or Homes of Delcambre Citizens*". MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderman Timothy Derise "moved to amend ordinance - Sec. 13-13 CUSTOMER SECURITY/STREET LIGHT FEE INCREASE. Street lighting declared a public utility; service charge; definition.
(a) The furnishing by the town of street lights is hereby declared to be a revenue producing public utility.
(b) In order to provide for the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the Town of Delcambre, there is hereby levied a service charge to defray the expenses of street lights, to be assessed and collected monthly, as follows:

(1) Upon each owner of a residence \$3.00
(2) Upon each owner of an apartment building, per apartment 3.00
(3) Upon each commercial establishment 3.00
(c) For the purposes of this section, the word "apartment" shall be construed to mean a living or residential unit containing usual and ordinary kitchen facilities. Ord. No. 87-09, §§ 1,3, 4-13-87" Fee increase to be .50 per billing cycle ((from \$3.00 per billing cycle to \$3.50 per billing cycle). YEAS: 4 NAYS: 0 ABSTAINED: 0 ABSENT 0: Motion Carried.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderman Timothy Derise "moved to ENACT SECTION 10-1 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Delcambre, Louisiana, as they relate to planning and Development for the use of **Recreational Vehicles Within the Corporate Limits of the Town of Delcambre.**
