
Paul was at AFVN when I got there in August 1970. Later on he went to the Chu Lai Detachment to supervise the closing down of that detachment. I had a room in the Plaza with twin beds, one of which was intentionally left empty so I could host senior NCOs visiting Saigon from one or another of the detachments Paul bunked with me several times when visiting from Chu Lai, then moved in permanently when he was assigned back to the Saigon station in November 1970. In late January 1971, Paul was transferred to AFN. You can read more by going to the MACOI site shown below. I recall hearing that after he and his wife settled down in Germany, he became rather ill and then passed away while still fairly young.




Paul's performance comes to a climax and he waits for the applause.
