

DR. HERMAN C. VOLZ

1925-1993

Dr. Herman Carl Volz, 67, a native of Sebewasing and more recently of Rochester, NY, died Sunday, April 26, in Genesee Hospital, Rochester.

Dr. Volz was born Nov. 14, 1925, in Sebewasing, son of the late John A. and Amalia (Lutat) Volz. He was married to Beverly Mae Hartz in Bay City on Jan. 28, 1963, and she survives him.

He received his BS Degree and MS Degree from Michigan Technological University and his doctorate from Case Institute of Technology in Cleveland, OH. Doctor Volz was a research chemist at Rochester General Hospital from 1972 until his retirement in 1990.

He was a member of Christ View United Methodist Church in Rochester. He was also a member of the American Chemical Society. Doctor Volz served in the U.S. Army in the Philippine Islands during World War II.

Surviving, besides his wife Beverly is one son, William Carl Volz of Charlotte, NC; three sisters, Mrs. Arthur (Inez) Nitz and Mrs. Clemence (Grace) Esch, of Sebewasing, and Mrs. James (Betty) Burke of Denver, CO; one brother, Elmer Volz of Sebewasing, and several nieces and nephews.

A service was held Friday morning in Dinkel Juergel Funeral Home, Sebewasing. Rev. Lawrence Brooks, pastor of Trinity United Methodist Church, Sebewasing, officiated and burial was in Elm Lawn Cemetery, Bay City.
