KIWANIS MEETING OF March 27th, 2017

Our program speakers were two employees of Delaware North, the company that handles food and beverage concessions at Lambeau Field. Delaware North has been serving food at stadiums since 1919, and currently serves over 60 stadiums. The company recruits local organizations to provide workers for the concession booths and pays the organizations a percentage of their sales. The organizations can provide as few as two workers, or more than 50. Five local organizations that provided workers last year each earned over \$30,000.
