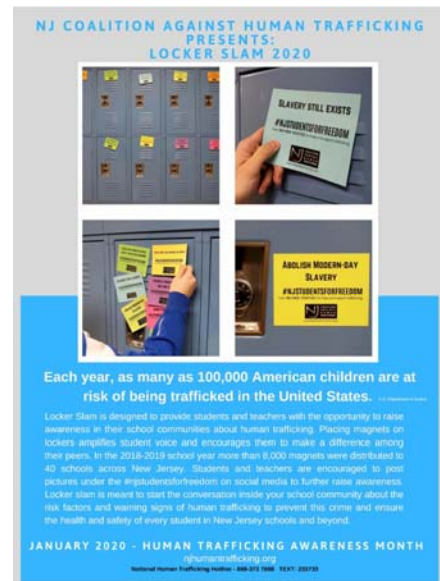

Why LOCKER SLAM matters

Locker Slam brings awareness of human trafficking directly into NJ middle and high schools, as well as a means for victims to gain help. The program also helps to create the next generation of abolitionists.

Young people are both vulnerable to being trafficked, and can see what's going on among their peers. They can help bring an end to modern day slavery by understanding what it is, and helping to protect their friends.



28,000 magnets arrive...each box is extremely heavy!

The 7 designs are put into a variety of box sizes so that schools get the right number for their student population

Schools receive an average of 350 magnets, but larger schools (over 1,500 students) will receive more and smaller schools will receive fewer. We aim to send enough magnets for 1 in 4 school lockers.
