"If another member of the church sins against you, go and point out the fault when the two of you are alone. If the member listens to you, you have regained that one" (Matthew 18:15).

Then Peter came and said to him, "Lord, if another member of the church sins against me, how often should I forgive? As many as seven times?" Jesus said to him, "Not seven times, but, I tell you, seventy-seven times" (Matthew 18:21-22).

Dear Friends in Christ.

As I write this, I have been serving you for two weeks. I have talked to many of you, and I have heard lots of things! Needless to say, I will speak with many more. Please give me a call if you want to set something up.

Take a look at the two passages above: the first is instruction from Jesus, the second is an exchange between Jesus and Peter. *Regarding the second passage...*

Does Peter ever consider HE could sin against someone else?

Is Peter proud of his loving generosity by forgiving someone as many as seven times?

How often, when we read a passage like this, do we think it is for SOMEONE ELSE, and not for us?

How about if we do some editing to these two passages...

"If you sin against another member of the church, go and confess your fault when the two of you are alone. If the member is gracious enough to listen to you and forgive, the two of you have renewed your relationship."

Then Peter came and said to him, "Lord, if I sin against another member of the church, how many times should he forgive me? As many as seven times?" Jesus said to him, "Not seven times, but, I tell you, seventy -seven times" (Matthew 18:21-22).

My brothers and sisters, we all know someone with whom we need to speak. Of course, it is easy to see ourselves as Peter, when someone sins against *us*. But how many are willing to look in the mirror and admit otherwise, we might sin against someone else?

It is hard to approach someone. It is hard to begin to reconcile. It is hard to forgive. It is hard to heal.

My friends, PRAY about how you are going to approach that person (or persons!). You know who they are. Ask God to give you an opportunity to begin the journey of reconciliation and healing. If you would like me to help begin the process, I am happy to help.

My work is just beginning – please be patient with me as I learn names and faces, and thanks in advance for your forgiveness if I forget someone! The road ahead will be difficult, but I remain confident and hopeful we will reach our destination, which is the arrival of the person whom God has called to lead Mars UP into the future.

Please continue with me the journey thru Lent to Holy Week, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and the joy of Easter and the Resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Don't forget, Easter is the reason we are here...

GRIEFSHARE is a special weekly seminar/support group for people grieving the death of someone close. It's a place where you can be around people who understand how you feel and the pain of your loss. GriefShare meets in the library on Mondays from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. The meetings are being sponsored by McDonald Aeberli Funeral Home. No preregistration is required.

SEMINAR TOPICS

Each week your group will watch a video seminar on DVD. The GriefShare videos cover topics essential to your recovery from the hurt of grief and loss. The videos are produced in a compelling television magazine format and feature interviews with grief recovery experts, dramatic reenactments, on-location video and real-life stories of people who have experienced the death of a loved one. Here is a list of the weekly topics:

LIVING WITH GRIEF — SESSION 1

This session introduces you to GriefShare. It also explains what living with grief is like, why you shouldn't be ashamed of your grief and why you shouldn't rush through your healing.

THE JOURNEY OF GRIEF — SESSION 2

This session prepares you for what to expect along the journey of grief. At the same time, it emphasizes that everyone's journey is unique and warns against comparing grief experiences.

THE EFFECTS OF GRIEF — SESSION 3

You're probably surprised at how debilitating grief is. This session explains that this is normal and suggests practical ways to find comfort.

WHEN YOUR SPOUSE DIES — SESSION 4

If you've lost your spouse, this session helps you think through the critical issues involved in your healing. It also begins preparing you to face the difficult transition into a new reality without your spouse.

YOUR FAMILY AND GRIEF — SESSION 5

This session shares how to keep your family afloat when its members are drowning in grief. It also presents some of the unique issues involved if you're grieving the death of a child.

WHY? — SESSION 6

Just because God doesn't answer all of your questions doesn't mean He won't answer any of them. This session answers the "Why" questions and encourages you to begin asking other questions as well.

THE UNIQUENESS OF GRIEF, PT. 1 — SESSION 7

This session explores how the causes of, and your responses to, your loved one's death affect your grief. Topics addressed include suicide, long-term illness, murder and false guilt.

THE UNIQUENESS OF GRIEF, PT. 2 — SESSION 8

Relationships, past and present, affect your grief. This session helps you address insensitive comforters and unresolved conflict with a deceased loved one.

GOD'S PRESCRIPTION FOR GRIEF - SESSION 9

The bereaved are often overwhelmed by the advice they receive from others. And often, what goes unnoticed is what God says about healing. This session tells you how to position yourself to experience God's healing.

STUCK IN GRIEF — SESSION 10

It's easy to get stuck along the journey of grief, This session explains how to keep moving on the path to healing.

TOP TWENTY LESSONS OF GRIEF, PT. 1 — SESSION 11

In this session, those who've walked the journey of grief will share what they've learned and how they've grown from their grief experience.

TOP TWENTY LESSONS OF GRIEF, PT. 2 — SESSION 12

In this session you'll hear the most significant lessons that can be learned during grief.



Recent Update at Mars UP Church

The Session of the Mars United Presbyterian Church has unanimously voted to welcome **My School Preschool** to operate in our Church. **My School Preschool** is a Christian based preschool rooted in the Mars community for over 20 years. The preschool has an excellent reputation with teachers employed by the Mars School district and parents of this church and community. The preschool currently offers five different classes with class size capped at sixteen and currently enrolls approximately 85 students. The preschool has a governing Board of seven Directors, four are required to be members of the Mars United Presbyterian Church and the remaining are interested parents or friends of the preschool.

My School Preschool will occupy all but one room on the second floor of the church beginning in August, Monday through Friday following the Mars School district calendar. **My School Preschool** will pay a building fee, accounting fee and insurance for use of the building. Previously scheduled heating improvements by the Building and Grounds committee will be completed in the spring. A safety locking system will be added to the second floor front door from the sanctuary and the second floor double wood doors from the back entrance.

The Session gladly accepts the opportunity to collaborate with the **My School Preschool** group in providing a community outreach Christian preschool and hopes that the Church membership will share our enthusiasm in receiving them.


