

Unwind at Ohiopyle's RnR Acres

I recently spent two relaxing days at RnR Acres, a lovely cottage just up the road from downtown Ohio Pyle, PA . Like the name implies, this sweet hideaway is set back away from the road, allowing a private and cozy stay for you and yours.

When you turn at 800 Dinnerbell Road and drive down RnR lane, the world opens up to a yard big enough to play kick ball or do cart wheels or play catch. It is such a pleasant surprise to have acreage surrounding you at a vacation rental that you will all jump from the car ready for fun. The fire pit to the right is covered for protection awaiting your arrival, with chairs to sit and chill while watching your camp fire.

You will follow a stone path onto the patio with a large gas grille, table and umbrella. Through glass doors you enter the open living and kitchen area. I loved the wide counter with stools and the two-top table eat-in kitchen. In my opinion, the kitchen makes any house and RnR has captured the art of welcoming you to gather and enjoy the amenities.

The fully stocked kitchen includes a coffee maker, tea pot, pots, pans, dishes, mixing bowls, utensils, silverware, dishwasher, microwave, refrigerator, oven, a work area butler with cutting boards, and my favorite...a gas stove. Just off the kitchen, a nice sized deck allows for more spots to dine or just enjoy a little RnR.

The cottage offers two bedrooms, each with a queen bed. In the utility room there is a futon along with a washer and drier for your convenience. Linens are provided along with extra pillows, blankets and hangers. The bath is equipped with a glass door shower and even stocks a hair dryer. Wifi, a fireplace, cable TV, heat, and air conditioning make your stay at the RnR smooth as silk.

To the right of the cottage, an easy-to-access hot tub awaits you and if you are so inclined, don't forget to walk up the hill to catch an amazing sunset or two.

Although I expected to see deer, it was a Red Cardinal who kept me company at the RnR. I kept hearing something tapping on the glass door. The resident Cardinal wanted to say hello, repeatedly.
