✠ **SAINTS/FEASTS OF THE WEEK** ✠

May 13-Our Lady of of Fatima-Between May 13 and October 13, 1917, three Portuguese children—Francisco and Jacinta Marto and their cousin Lucia dos Santos—received apparitions of Our Lady at Co-va da Iria near Fatima, a city 110 miles north of Lisbon. Mary asked the children to pray the rosary for world peace, for the end of World War I, for sinners, and for the conversion of Russia. Mary gave the children three secrets. Following the deaths of Francisco and Jacinta in 1919 and 1920 respectively, Lucia revealed the first secret in 1927. It concerned devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The second secret was a vision of hell. When Lucia grew up she became a Carmelite nun and died in 2005 at the age of 97. Pope John Paul II directed the Holy See’s Secretary of State to reveal the third secret in 2000; it spoke of a “bishop in white” who was shot by a group of soldiers who fired bullets and arrows into him. —*Franciscanmedia.org*

May 14-St. Matthias, Apostle—According to the Acts of the Apostles, St. Matthias was chosen to replace Judas Iscariot after his betrayal.

May 15-St. Isidore —Often referred to as the last scholar of the ancient world, St. Isidore was the Archbishop of Seville for over 30 years.

May 18-Pope St. John I -Pope John I was Pope from 13 August 523 to his death in 526. He was a native of Siena, in Italy. He was sent on a diplomatic mission to Constantinople by the Ostrogoth King Theoderic to negotiate better treatment for Arians. (*Wikipedia*). Upon his return to Rome, was imprisoned by King Theoderic. Pope John died in prison in 526. -*Wikipedia*

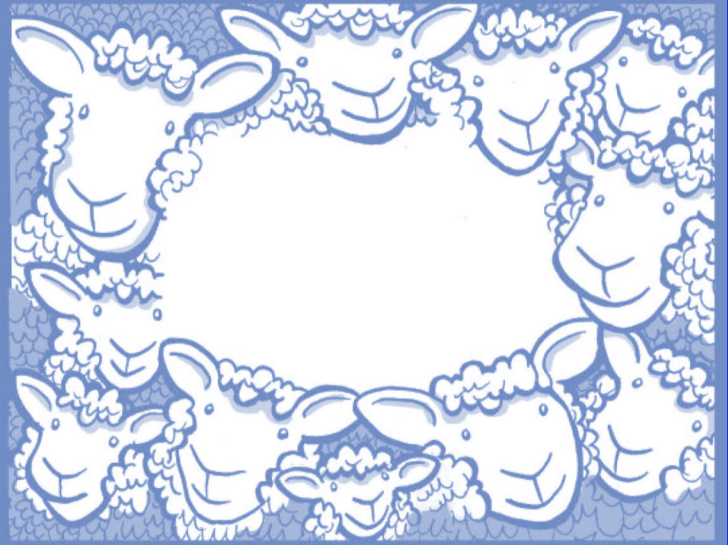

MIS OVEJAS ESCHUCHAN MI VOZ



12 de mayo de 2019 • Cuarto Domingo de Pascua

Jesús dice: “mis ovejas escuchan mi voz; yo las conozco y ellas me siguen”. Un poco antes en el discurso del Buen Pastor, Juan el evangelista explica que Jesús está usando “un lenguaje figurado”. No podemos tomar las palabras de Jesús literalmente, ya que somos personas, no ovejas. Entendemos al Señor figurativamente, luego, descubrimos todas las formas útiles que son similares a las ovejas. Una búsqueda rápida en Internet pone de manifiesto un número de videos mostrando cómo una oveja ignora la voz de cada persona excepto la de su pastor. Es sorprendente ver cómo las ovejas son de una mente firme, totalmente absortas pastoreando, ignorando todo lo que está a su alrededor. Aun cuando imitadores reproduzcan al pastor y las llame de la misma manera que el pastor lo hace, las ovejas ni siquiera se molestan en voltear a ver. El momento en que el verdadero pastor las llame, es entonces cuando prestan atención, respondiendo al llamado a su manera y vienen corriendo.

¡PEGADIZO!

Es de gran ayuda pensar en nuestra conexión con Jesús en términos de oveja. Nuestros corazones anhelan escuchar

la voz de Jesús y responder tan rápido como lo hacen los animales de una granja. Sin embargo, en realidad ninguno de nosotros, hoy en día, vivió en la Palestina del primer siglo. Nunca escuchamos a Jesús decírnos, en su propio idioma, cómo él nunca permitiría que alguien nos alejara de su presencia. Aquí otra vez pensamos en forma figurada, luego imaginamos esas “voces” en la vida diaria que nos ayuda con un chasquido a poner atención y acercarnos a Jesús. El Evangelio de hoy nos invita a dedicar tiempo pensando en todo lo que nos lleva al Señor. Las conversaciones, las Escrituras, los deportes, la hospitalidad, el servicio, la música, las risas, las dificultades, cualquiera de estas cosas podría ayudar a nuestros oídos a reaccionar mientras vemos al Señor. Al practicar escuchar “la voz”, podemos sorprendernos darnos cuenta lo frecuente que Jesús ha estado llamándonos durante los asuntos de nuestros días. Cuando tengamos su voz en nuestros oídos, esperemos nunca perder ese tono de voz.

No one can take them out of my hand.” But we who are free to live our faith peacefully sometimes take our membership in Jesus’ flock for granted, wandering astray to seek our own pleasure and prosperity. The simple cross that Pope Francis always wears seems to show us how Jesus responds to that. Francis’s cross features an image of Jesus, who has sought and found a lost sheep, then joyfully set it on his shoulders to carry it gently home. TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The reception of Holy Communion at Sunday Mass is such an expected feature of the Mass these days that it is surprising to realize that for many centuries, receiving Communion was a relatively rare event in the life of a faithful Christian. “Easter duty” means that Catholics must celebrate reconciliation if aware of serious sin, and receive Holy Communion during the Easter season. For a while, this was a requirement of Easter week, and later extended to the whole season of fifty days, and even beyond that by a few weeks. For the majority of people long ago, this meant Communion was a once-a-year moment. A rather complex bureaucracy grew up around this rule in the Middle Ages. Amazingly, people received a kind of token at confession admitting them to Communion in their home parish, which then kept careful records and reported them to the bishop.

Surviving records can tell us a great deal about our ancestors. In fact, people were encouraged to journey to the church of their baptism in order to fulfill their duty, and therefore the Easter duty includes in its origins a grateful pilgrimage to the font in which you were first embraced by Christ. If your “Holy Mother Church” is within a drive, why not make a pilgrimage to that font a feature of your Easter celebration of these fifty days?—James Field, Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

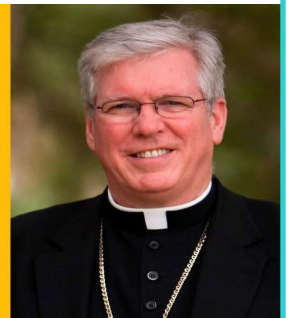
