#### MISSION & OUTREACH COMMITTEE UPDATE

Thank you to everyone who participated in the drive for the YWCA Shelter in April.

The woman at the desk who received the items was positively giddy at the amount and quality of the donations. They were apparently running short of several of the items we collected. Thank you for making the lives of the women and children living there a bit less stressful and more comfortable.

For May, we have started a collection of money to be sent to Chogoria Presbytery in Kenya, our sister Presbytery, to be used for the food program at the Mpangua School. If you remember the cardboard bricks we "bought" a few years ago, that was to build the school. Now we are trying to help feed the students there so they can continue to learn. There is no USDA-equivalent to subsidize noon lunch in Kenya. Parents are expected to provide money or food for the children. The region where the Mpangua school is located is extremely poor at any time, but they are in the midst of a multi-year drought, and many of the parents can barely feed their families, much less send a lunch to school. The school cooks have been feeding the children, and therefore running out of food. The money we collect will be sent through our Presbytery to assure it reaches the proper fund, and is spent accountably. Please give through the offering envelopes in the pews, or mark your checks to designate them for Kenya, or Mpangua. Thank you!

Our June and July mission focus will again be a collection of diapers for Churches United, to be used at the Shelter, in the various apartment buildings they manage, or given through their Food Pantries. This year, we will be collecting size 5 & 6 diapers. And don't forget the wipes! Swim diapers are also welcome, as they take the kiddos swimming as an activity during the summer. Thank you again for your support of this ministry.

#### **SUMMER PEACHES**

Red River Youth for Christ (RRYC) once again plans to sell their fresh peaches throughout the summer. Georgia peaches will be delivered in June and early July while Colorado peaches will be delivered in August.

RRYC offers fruit as a fundraiser to help support its ministry to at-risk youth in the F-M area. Their mission is to make young people feel seen, heard, and valued. They reach teens at pivotal moments by serving weekly meals to hungry students, providing programing within the regional juvenile center, mentoring and equipping teen moms, providing safe, healthy, and life-giving relationships, and so much more. YOU make all this possible. When you buy fruit, the lives of young people in our community are impacted and changed forever.


