

RAMA SWIM & RACQUET CLUB, INC.
2016 Membership Rules & Code of Conduct

Our family has reviewed and accepts the rules listed below and the attached Code of Conduct and agrees to abide by all that is listed herein. These rules and regulations apply to all Club property. This includes pool, pool enclosures, tennis courts, volleyball courts, parking lot, driveways, clubhouse and adjacent areas. These pool rules supersede any other posted or previously signed membership rules and code of conduct.

POOL RULES

- NO talking to on duty lifeguards.
- NO running, pushing, or horseplay in pool area.
- NO glass containers in pool area.
- NO swimming in diving area without lifeguard's permission.
- The presence of members or guests on the Club property is restricted to the posted operating hours. Any use of the property at other hours without permission of the Board is prohibited. Violations may result in arrest for the trespass and/or suspension or revocation of membership.
- Children under 10 (turns 10 prior to September 1st) are not allowed in pool area unless accompanied by an adult. Children 10 to 18 must have passed a basic swim test each season to be in the pool area without an adult.
- The kiddie pool is for children 4 years old or younger. Adult supervision is required.
- Children not toilet trained are required to wear swim diapers. Swim diapers are available for purchase at front desk.
- Any person with infections, skin abrasions, inflamed sores, or wearing bandages may be denied use of the pool.
- Only one person allowed on the diving board and ladder at a time.
- Anyone using profanity may be subject to dismissal.
- Only on-duty staff members and board members are allowed in office and concession area.
- Flotation devices are allowed at the discretion of the lifeguards.
- No pets are allowed.
- Adult swim periods are restricted to those 18 years and older.
- Guests must be signed in and accompanied by a member at all times. Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests.
- Smoking in designated area only.
- Baby sitters have to be at least 14 (turns 14 prior to September 1st) years of age to supervise children who are not accompanied by an adult.
- Alcoholic beverages (no glass containers) can be consumed on club property by persons over the age of 21 at any time except during swim meets which are governed by swim league rules. Persons consuming alcohol are expected to exercise discretion and judgment that upholds the family atmosphere of the club and is respectful of all members and their guests. Anyone not meeting these expectations will be asked to leave the premises immediately and/or the police will be called.
- Swimmers must be able to swim the width of the diving well without the aid of flotation devices to swim in the diving well. Guards may ask swimmers to demonstrate their ability. All children jumping/diving off the board must be able to swim the width of the diving well.

Violation of these rules may cause dismissal for the day. Repeated violation may result in removal from the Club.

MEMBERS' CODE OF CONDUCT

To maintain our Club's standards, the Board of Governors and Club Management have created the following Member's Code of Conduct. This is written with your fellow Member's interests in mind and to ensure a Club atmosphere that is safe and enjoyable for all. We hope by joining together to observe these principles, we will maintain the positive family community for which our Club is known as Members of Rama Swim and Racquet Club, parents must assume responsibility for the conduct of their children. The Board accepts responsibility for setting appropriate standards for Members and their children, while at the Club or when representing the Club elsewhere.

It is our intent to ensure an appropriate response to violations in a timely and consistent manner. The staff will first speak to children and their parents if they are present, about any inappropriate behavior. Serious or continuous inappropriate behavior will be brought to the Club Manager's attention and may result in suspension of privileges. If further problems occur, the Board of Directors may take more serious disciplinary action.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

A Club community should provide a supportive family environment, where respect for others and appropriate social skills are demonstrated at all times. As representatives of the membership, the Board of Directors presents this code of conduct to our Members to set forth its expectations regarding the behavior of members and their children.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES

1. Parents are responsible for their children's behavior at all times. Please review and enforce this code of conduct with your children.
2. Members and their guests are expected to act in a responsible and appropriate manner at all times. Members are responsible for guest fees and conduct of guests.
3. Keep your children safe by properly supervising them at all times.
4. Courtesy and respect of the Members, guests, and staff at the Club must be demonstrated at all times.
5. Ethnic, disability or sexist jokes, racial or religious slurs, taunting, cursing and intimidating behavior will not be tolerated.
6. Children are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship at the Club and when representing the Club at away events.
7. Rollerblades, skateboards, etc. are not allowed on club sidewalks, tennis courts, and pool decks. To clarify, rollerblades, skateboards, etc. are only allowed in the asphalt parking area on Club property.

GENERAL CONDUCT

1. All members and guests are expected to maintain decorum and not be disruptive when in the Club. The Club reserves the right to remove members from the Club who fail to abide by these rules.
2. While at the Club, parents are asked to prevent their children from playing in the office area, running in office or pool deck areas or wandering unsupervised in any areas of the Club.
3. Children under the age of 10 (turns 10 prior to September 1st) must be accompanied by an adult when they enter the Club.
4. Children must be 14 (turns 14 prior to September 1st) years or older to baby sit an unaccompanied child under the age of 10.
5. Any member (members are responsible for guests), who litters, vandalizes or causes malicious mischief in or on pool property will immediately rectify the damage, pay all costs necessary to rectify any damage, and/or accept suspension or revocation of membership.

JUNIOR TEAM SPORTS PARTICIPANTS CONDUCT

The primary goals of the Club's Youth Teams are to provide an opportunity for youths to; one, share fellowship and friendly competition in an atmosphere of respect, acceptance and considerate behavior, and two, to represent the Club community. These rules apply to the swimming, tennis, volleyball and any other organized event.

For the safety of all Club Youths and in order to achieve these goals, the following guidelines must be adhered to:

1. Participate enthusiastically on the team. Be punctual and attentive to the coach.
2. Follow the rules of the sport.
3. Wear appropriate clothing for the sport according to the Club's dress code.
4. Accept the decisions of officials or coaches with good grace and show good sportsmanship at all times. Treat your teammates and opponents with respect.
5. Accept the responsibility and the privilege of representing your Club and team; display a positive attitude at all times.
6. Show respect for the property of others.
7. Give special consideration and encouragement to younger participants.

POOL CONDUCT

The lifeguards and management are authorized to stop any and all unsafe activities as well as to deal with any inappropriate behavior and enforce all rules. Please refer to the RULES in this document and posted at the Pool.

CONCESSION STAND "PIRATES COVE" AND POOL DECK CONDUCT

1. Children dining in the snack bar area are expected to conduct themselves in a manner respectful of other members, guests and the staff.
2. While at the Pirates Cove, parents are asked to prevent their children from running or playing on the tables.
3. Everyone is expected to clean up after themselves while dining at the snack bar or on the pool deck.
