- 1. Participants and spectators at any recreational activity assume all risks and hazards associated with any event offered by the Association or on its facilities.
- 2. As a condition of using Association facilities, all participants agree to hold harmless the Association, its staff, directors, committee members and any other authorized representatives from liability for any losses, damages or injuries that may occur in any way as a result of these activities or facility uses, regardless of cause.
- 3. Participants (or the parents/guardians of minor children) may also be required to complete a medical health history and/or sign an additional waiver of liability prior to participation in any recreational activities.
- 4. Anyone recovering from an injury or illness must first discuss their return to physical activity with their physician prior to participating in any activities.
- 5. In case of an emergency, call 911.
