

Code of Conduct

- **Communication**

The Neolea instructors communicate with dancers through email, texting system (Remind 101) and through the website (www.neoleahellenicdancers.com). It is the responsibility of each dancer to check their email, texts and the web for information on practices, performances, videos of dances practiced or to be practiced, traveling information, and other miscellaneous important news. Emails and texts are sent out frequently, and each requires much attention.

- **Attendance**

Regular attendance is expected of each dancer. Dancers should notify an instructor if they will be missing a practice. Once a dancer has arrived at practice, it is their responsibility to sign-in. Dancers are expected to uphold performance commitments so that the group can fulfill its obligations. In case of unforeseen circumstances, a dancer must notify the instructors immediately if he/she cannot attend a performance. Dancers scheduled to perform must attend final practice prior to the performance.

- **Punctuality**

Punctuality at practice is a necessity so that practice time may be maximized! Dancers are required to attend practice sessions in their entirety. If a dancer must leave early, please inform an instructor in advance.

It is mandatory for dancers to be punctual to performances in order to allow time to prepare or make changes.

- **Behavior**

Talking during instruction should be limited to questions directed to instructors.

There are a couple breaks during practice, as well as time before and after practice for socializing and other questions.

Gum chewing is not allowed.

Cell phones should be on silent and only checked during breaks, before and after practice.

Dancers are required to act responsibly in a disciplined manner and respect the property and company of others.

- **Attire**

Appropriate dance shoes and attire are required for all, both at practice and performances.

Likewise, a dancer must have the proper undergarments, socks, tights, shoes, etc. at each performance in order to uphold our professionalism.

No flip-flops or revealing clothing should be worn at practice.
