

Let's welcome Andrew Mack this month as our speaker. It is his first time to visit us. Andrew is a Licensed Freshwater Fishing Guide, owner of Macks Fish Reports & Guide Service. He is also the only registered bow fishing guide for Big Bear Lake and offers trout trips as well. Besides his own social media pages, he does social media for Evike.com and runs saltwater trips for them. He is the freshwater guy and a part of the Angler Chronicles Crew, doing both TV and radio for them. He is a representative for Bite-ON Red Crimson and is also featured on the label of each bottle. He promotes the Fishing Syndicate Trout Series rods. He has been an IGFA Representative since 2021 and holds a certificate for the IGFA Trout Super Grand Slam Club for catching four different species of trout on the same day as well as a Royal Slam certificate for catching 7 trout species in a lifetime. And you likely have seen his name as a writer for Western Outdoor News.

As a bow fisherman, Andrew has removed thousands of invasive carp from Big Bear Lake to Lake Elsinore as well as other inland lakes where bow fishing is legal.

President's Message for May 2024

The active fishing season has started. The shows and conventions are over and now the fight to be freshwater and/or saltwater angler of the year begins! An early lead in freshwater has already been established by an early season win by Jose M Dominguez! Can he hold the lead and sweep thru to the championship? That remains to be seen. This year the club has 15 club events (worth double points on the whopper board) which you can attend. These events are not the only events in which you can make whopper board entries but include:

I know there are 16 dates shown. Remember our Angler of the Year competition runs from November 1 to November 1 of each year.

RULES for overnight trips

- 1. We board the boat in the order in which you purchased your charter UNLESS you have a medical need i.e. C Pap machine or need to be near an electrical outlet.
- 2. We fish the best fishing available. The captain decides where we fish and what species we go after. I will try to make a determination but it's captains' choice.
- 3. I need the name and phone number of ALL non club members you are bringing on the charters. Preferably a number at which they can receive a text message as I send out text messages to all anglers on a charter with trip information.
- 4. I do not control the weather, fuel surcharges or if the boat adds an extra \$3.00 to put bacon on your cheeseburger.
- 5. Bring your own bedding. Covid, not being the problem it once was, is still considered a threat.
- 6. If you are ill for ANY reason, STAY HOME. Come on the next trip.

With your entry they provide a special measuring device to each person and an app to submit your entries. All the details are online at: https://ccacalifornia.org/star/ You can enter up to 2 fish per day per category. This increases your chances of winning. Each entry gets you into the drawings for prizes. California fish only.

Eligible fish include:

- Saltwater Bass: Sand Bass, Calico Bass, Spotted Bay Bass (18 inches)
- California Halibut (28 inches)
- Yellowtail (36 inches)
- White Seabass (36 inches)
- Tuna: Bluefin, Yellowfin, Big Eye, Albacore (36 inches)

This Tournament is going to grow every year. This is a good time to get in at the beginning. There are weekly drawings also with great prizes. You only have to submit a fish to possibly win, it doesn't have to be the largest catch.

Departure times are tentative. They can change if everyone shows up. <u>Printed date is the date you will be fishing</u>. Overnight trips load the night before. Full payment is required to reserve a spot. Prices subject to change if surcharge is charged to the Club. Make checks payable to William Davis. Expect to pay cash for your own food, tips and fish cleaning on the boats as always. No coolers, alcohol or drugs to be brought on board. Please plan to buy your food on board, we have a galley minimum to meet.

I ask that younger more agile members and guests take the upper and lower bunks leaving the middle bunks to the more senior(age) members and guests. Bring your own bedding and no food is allowed in the bunk room. Due to limited tackle box space, please consider bringing smaller or soft sided tackle box.

THE CHARTERMASTER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO OVERBOOK THE TRIPS BY ONE PERSON TO ENSURE THE CLUB DOES NOT LOSE MONEY.

Each trip stands alone. By that I mean each trip is a separate entity. You can write a check for multiple trips. Bring your own bedding on trips. Do not show up sick.

All Club members and guests are expected to abide by the Department of Fish and Wildlife rules.

I will contact you prior to each trip. Each trip is best fishing available so don't call and ask. Come prepared.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR LARGE FISH

To estimate the weight of a Bluefin/Yellowfin Tuna, the following universally recognized formula will be accepted: *Measure fork length; multiply by the girth squared; then divide by 800.* This method may be used only when the catch is over 50 pounds, and a digital scale is unavailable. The weigh-in process must be photographed. It must be performed by a qualified crewmember, and the results recorded in a dated signed statement.

NEWS FROM THE BOARD

It was brought up at the most recent Board meeting that good sportsmanship includes the careful handling of juvenile fish. When the Board agreed in 2022 that all legal fish were eligible for the Whopper Board, they assumed that the members would not submit juvenile fish for points on the Whopper Board. Good sportsmanship does not include the weighing of juvenile fish. Juvenile fish are to be handled minimally, kept in the water if possible while removing the hook. Also, since it is not a Whopper, a photo is not necessary either. The Board is requesting that the members remember this and refrain from handling all juvenile fish.

ONLY AT TURNER'S ROD & REEL CLUB

In April we started a special drawing for a Daiwa Tanacom 500 electric reel. It retails at \$599.99 plus tax. This reel will be excellent for fishing rockfish 300 feet and deeper. We will have this reel to display at the meetings. The drawing will be held the first week of July. Tickets will be \$20 each or 6 for \$100.
