



happy to announce our fifth ordination since the restoration of the diaconate as a full and permanent order in the Church. It will take place on Saturday, <u>August 24th</u>, at 10:30 AM, when the candidate, <u>Jules Dupuis</u>, ready to accept the mission entrusted to him by his bishop, will become a deacon. The celebration, presided over by the Most Reverend Valéry Vienneau, will be held at the Saint-Jean -Antoine l'Ermite church in Saint-Antoine.
