November Business:

- Most important we are always available to you if you need us for anything, call and leave a message. Laura, Rex, Janie and others will always be there to help. You are not forgotten even if you don't see us as often.
- As painful as it is, we will have no gatherings at the Rec Hall until further notice. At the time things get better and it is safe for us to get together we will start to schedule events. We will continue to post monthly notices on the website for download.
- We are still trying to continue the tradition of Luminaries. We will have to make sure we wear masks and distance but we do believe with help we can pull it off. See December notice for more information.
- When using the laundry please wipe down the machines after use. We don't want to spread any possible virus germs.
- The dumpster rules are the same: We ask that you cut open and flatten cardboard boxes and crush plastic jugs and bottles to save space. We share the dumpster with everyone so save space for your neighbor. With so much being delivered to our homes cardboard is an issue. Also a reminder to put NOTHING outside the dumpster on the ground. It will not be picked up by the driver. He doesn't get out of the truck.
- Keep your speed under 10 mph. People walk their dogs, ride bikes and stroll through the park at all hours of the day and night. We want them safe. DO NOT SPEED. You will be reprimanded. Please wear reflective clothing to make sure you are seen during twilight and dark hours.
- A reminder there is no parking on the grass or on roads that are not wide enough for 2 cars to pass unless loading or unloading temporarily. If you need extended time to load/unload see Laura first to make arrangements. You may park momentarily at the mailbox to pick up your mail.
- Please keep rugs, hoses and yard items off the lawn if you would like your grass cut. If not, you will be responsible to maintain your own lawn. It is not fair or even possible for the person to get off the mower, move your stuff and get back on the mower for every item left on the lawn.
- Remember this is our home, do all you can to keep everyone safe. The Pendergrass family wanted us all to know, they think of us as family and are very grateful we are all here.
