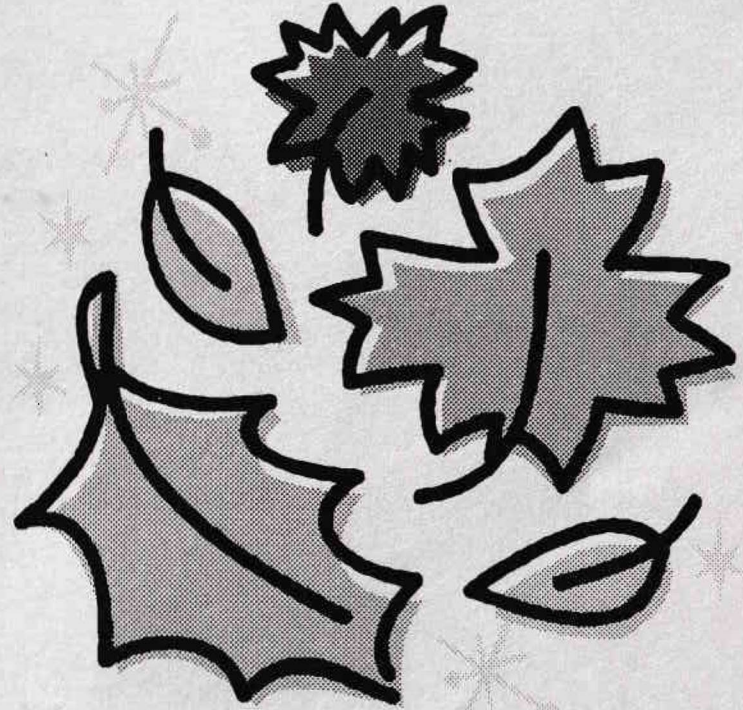

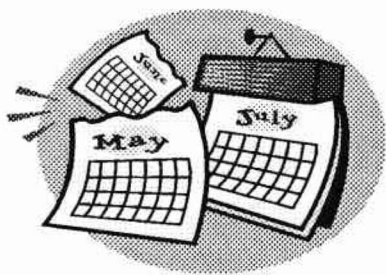

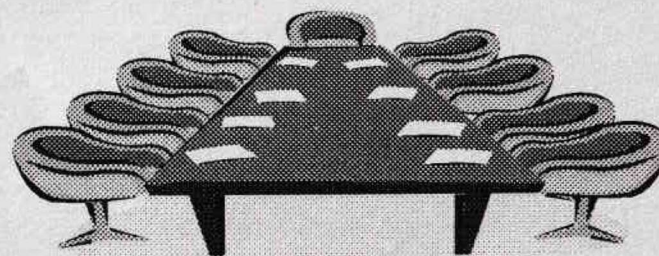

2004 DAYTON ALL * STAR QUALIFIERS



The All * Star Tournament is an annual tournament between the best darters from Dayton, Cincinnati, Cleveland and Columbus. It is being held on Sunday, November 21, in Columbus. You will be playing for the reputation of Dayton and the DDA – there's a large team trophy for first place, but there are no entry fees or payouts. The **Dayton All * Star Team** will consist of 28 men and 15 women. All team players receive a personalized Dayton All * Star shirt!

QUALIFYING

Who? ANY DARTER may attempt to qualify. If you are not a current DDA member, before 12:00 midnight on the last night of Qualifiers, you can purchase a DDA membership for only \$15. This will place your score on the standings and make you eligible to participate in the tournament.

How? Qualifiers will determine the first 24 men and 12 women. You pay \$3 per sheet (3 games per sheet) or 2 sheets for \$5 (must be played at the same Qualifier). You will throw 3 rounds at selected doubles (40pts.ea.) 14 rounds at score and 3 more rounds at selected doubles (40pts. Ea.) Your Qualifying score will be the total of the 3 games on one sheet. You can pay and play as many times as you want.

Two Match Play eliminations (1 for the men; 1 for the women) will determine the 4 alternates for the men and 3 alternates for the women. The October 23, 2004 Match Play will be a 501 (straight in, double out) double elimination format. The top 4 men and top 3 women will be added to the All * Star Team as alternates.

Open Qualifiers will be held from July 30 through October 15, **except from 7pm to 9pm on scheduled qualifying nights**. All you do is locate any DDA Board Member to receive your money and record your throws. One other DDA member must be present throughout your attempt and will sign the sheet as a witness. All Qualifiers must be held at DDA sponsored locations.

FEES: \$3.00 per attempt (3 "games"), or 2 attempts for \$5.00 (must be played at the same Qualifier for all Open and Scheduled Preliminary Qualifiers)
\$2.00 one-time fee for Match Play
