The Land of Lake Choir Boys was founded in 1976 as part of a bi-centennial celebration for the city of Elk River. Eighteen boys gathered for their first choir practice under the direction of Craig Carmody-Anderson. The choir has grown to an organization of over 100 boys making up six different choirs.

The choir has toured all 48 states, Hawaii, Canada, Australia, New Zealand and nine European countries. In June 1999, they were the only boys choir outside of Germany to have received the honor of opening the International Bach Festival and received a 10-minute standing ovation.

They continue to awe and inspire audiences with their unique sound and vast repertoire ranging from baroque to modern day hits.
