

ORDINANCE NO: 2020-12-01

**ORDINANCE REGARDING THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO BE LEVIED
FOR THE YEAR 2020**

WHEREAS, the TRUTH IN TAXATION ACT requires that all taxing districts in the State of Illinois determine the estimated amount of taxes necessary to be levied for the year not less than 20 days prior to the official adoption of the aggregate tax levy of the district, and

WHEREAS, if the estimated aggregate amount necessary to be levied, exclusive of election costs, exceed 105% of the aggregate amount of property taxes extended or estimated to be extended upon levy for the year 2019, public notice shall be given and public hearing shall be held on the taxing districts intent to adopt a tax levy in an amount which is more than 105% of the extension or estimated extension for the year 2019, and

WHEREAS, the aggregate amount of property taxes extended for this taxing district for the year 2019 payable in 2020 was

GENERAL CORPORATE PURPOSES: \$5,297.00
and

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that the estimated amount of taxes to be extended for the year 2020 payable in 2021 is as follows:

GENERAL CORPORATE PURPOSES: \$5,560.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the VILLAGE OF HAMBURG, COUNTY OF CALHOUN, STATE OF ILLINOIS

- SECTION I: The aggregate amount of taxes to be levied for the year 2020 payable in 2021 is: \$5,560.00.
- SECTION II: The aggregate amount of taxes estimated to be levied for the year 2020, payable in 2021 does not exceed 105% of the taxes extended by the taxing district in the year 2019, payable in 2020.
- SECTION III: Public Notice is not required to be published and public hearing is not required to be held on this matter.
- SECTION IV: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its passage.

TAX LEVY ORDINANCE 2020-12-02

WHEREAS THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the VILLAGE OF HAMBURG, in the COUNTY OF CALHOUN, STATE OF ILLINOIS, did on the 1st day of June, 2020, pass the annual appropriation bill for Fiscal Year May 1, 2020 to April 30, 2021 which is ascertained to be the sum of Forty-One Thousand Six Hundred Fifty and no/100 Dollars (\$41,650.00), which said appropriation bill was duly published.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hamburg, County of Calhoun, State of Illinois:

SECTION 1: That it be and is hereby levied upon all taxable property within the corporate limits of the Village of Hamburg subject to taxation for the year 2021 the total of Five Thousand Five Hundred Sixty and 00/100 Dollars (\$5,560.00), for the following specific purposes mentioned in and said Appropriation Bill and the respective sums as follows, to wit:
