Gary Holton, Cemetery Sexton, reported 2 cremations and 2 burials for the month and the flags will be removed after Veterans Day. It was agreed by the Board that there will be no cremation burials in the evenings, on Sundays or holidays.

Barry Gooding reported the Plan. Comm. Met 10/27/15 and reviewed changes in sign regulations and GAAMPS. The November meeting has been cancelled.
