HOPE4 RENOVATION

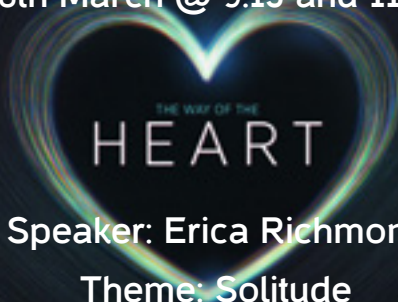
