The Purpose Project helps women:

- Own their stories with honesty, by accepting their pasts and building futures with purpose
- Escape the poverty that perpetuates the cycle of addiction and crime
- Find the stability that is needed to start a new life

Nearly a third of the felony offenders in Kaufman County are jailed for possessing illegal drugs. We spend millions prosecuting drug-related crime and jailing offenders, but without treatment or support, a drug-addicted woman's return to jail is almost guaranteed.



What We Do

The Purpose Project teaches women in the Kaufman County jail how to conquer their addictions and turn their lives around. We reduce their chances of relapse and recidivism by helping them find housing, employment, and necessary services upon their release. We guide them as they find peace in sobriety, accept their pasts, and create purposeful lives.

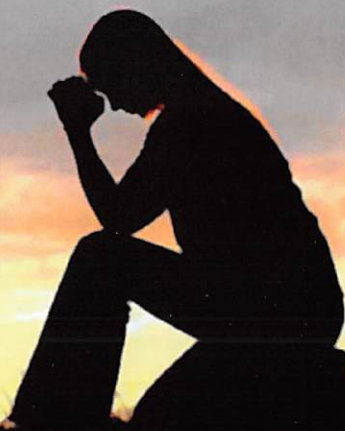
Without our support, many of the women in the Kaufman County jail will return to lives of crime, drug abuse and despair upon their release **because they have nowhere else to go.**
