Cats

My cats became therapy cats after very positive experiences with eldercare. They began by getting used to wearing a harness, then leash walking, riding in the car and learning some basic commands. Most long term care or assisted living facilities require you to bring in the cat's vaccination records once a year. The staff usually booked my kitties for 15 minute visits with residents and we usually spent 1 or 2 hours each trip as it was an hour away from home. It was very rewarding for me and the cats seemed

happy.

Therapeutic horseback riding uses a therapeutic team, usually including a certified therapeutic riding instructor, two or more volunteers, and a horse, to help an individual ride a horse and work with it on the ground.
