With <u>National Vietnam War Veterans Day</u> approaching, we are excited to report that collectively you are planning to host over **1,600 commemorative events** on and around <u>March 29</u>! It is especially gratifying that so many of you have continued to support the *noble mission* of *thanking and honoring Vietnam* veterans and their families well beyond your initial commitment of three years ... thank you!

We also are pleased to share that 38 of the 56 U.S. states, territories, and commonwealths have issued proclamations to commemorate this special day, which can be viewed on our website proclamations page. In addition, all 55 governors and the Mayor of Washington, D.C. have received a letter from our director encouraging them to host a commemorative event on March 29; the response has been wonderful!
